FRESH START HELPS REFUGEES AND ASYLUM SEEKERS TO FIND SUPPORT. WE RUN ENGLISH CONVERSATION CLASSES AT THE BELGRADE THEATRE, SATURDAY MORNING FOOTBALL SESSIONS AND NOURISH FOOD EVENTS IN CHURCHES THAT BRING PEOPLE TOGETHER FROM MANY DIFFERENT CULTURES.

OUR FAMILY LINK WORKER PROJECTS ARE AIMED AT SUPPORTING FAMILIES IN THE POOREST COMMUNITIES. WORKING WITH SCHOOLS AND CHURCHES, WE SEEK TO CREATE A NETWORK OF SUPPORT, TRAINING AND COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES THAT ENABLE FAMILIES TO STAY ABOVE THE POVERTY LINE AND RECEIVE THE EMOTIONAL, PHYSICAL AND SPIRITUAL SUPPORT THEY NEED.

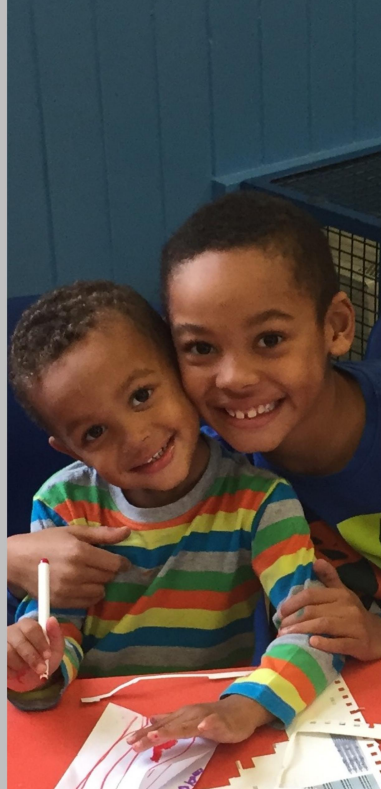
